## Summer Camp Details and Pricing

## Cooking Camp

*June 17 - June 21, 2019*

Children learn to mix, pour and chop their way to healthy eating, while exploring food from countries around the world. This camp has included local field trips to cook in professional kitchens!



## Prehistoric Camp
